Overall Goal:

Strengthened disaster and climate resilience in Tajikistan through trusted risk governance, reinforced EWS and improved risk knowledge

Duration:

1 September 2024 – 28 February 2026

Republic of Tajikistan

Outcome 1:

State authorities have improved risk governance and are actively engaged in disaster risk management.

Outcome 2:

Capacity of state authorities and stakeholders is enhanced to develop an effective early warning system through improved collection and management of risk knowledge and data

Within Outcome 1:

- 1.1 Tajikistan National Platform has strategic direction and thematic priorities established, and coordinates joint actions with relevant DRR stakeholders
- 1.2 A relevant and useful information system for the National Platform is maintained
- 1.3 Monitoring of the implementation of the National DRR Strategy and non-governmental stakeholder engagement in DRR processes and actions is planned by the National Platform

Within Outcome 2:

- 2.1 Greater capacity on the Early Warning System cycle is built
- 2.2 Understanding of historical disaster loss and damage is enhanced with spatial data infrastructure and risk data and information
- 2.3 Greater awareness on the need for disaster risk data and knowledge is developed
